To foster connection and support empowerment through equine and animal supported therapy.


VISION

It is our belief that through learning how to build mutually beneficial relationships with animals we begin to heal from past experiences, learn how to navigate difficult situations and feel more at peace in our lives.

OUR PROGRAMS

INDIVIDUAL PSYCHOTHERAPY

Equine & Animal Supported Psychotherapy captures the powerfully healing effects of the bond between humans and animals. It is our philosophy that everything that happens in our lives happens in the context of relationships; and that is how we begin to heal, through connection. Clients engage in this nature-based therapy through partnering with a horse or another farm animal of their choosing to learn how to build and maintain mutually beneficial relationships. Individual psychotherapy is facilitated by one of our licensed mental health professionals.



Partnering with an animal is a non-judgmental way to begin to heal from past wounds and learn more effective ways to engage in a relationship. Through this experiential therapy, these skills begin to create new pathways in our brain and enhance our daily interactions outside the farm, so that we can feel more empowered in our lives.

GROUP THERAPY

Experience the healing effects of the animal – human bond while also learning to engage in positive relationships with others. Group therapy is often very powerful as we begin to understand that we are not alone in our experiences. While everyone's experiences are unique, group therapy allows us to empathize with others and share in the mutual experience of the group.



Adding the animals into this experience allows us to stay present, understand our relationship patterns and dynamics within a group setting.

Recent case studies have proven that the progress clients make in traditional therapy in one year can be accomplished in equine supported psychotherapy in sixteen weeks! To empower our local Veterans to have even greater access to equine supported psychotherapy we began offering one day immersion experiences for Operation Warrior Horse and opened the farm as a Veteran's Rally Point once a month!

OPERATION WARRIOR HORSE

Operation Warrior Horse is a 10 week equine assisted psychotherapy program designed by Veterans for Veterans! This therapy group meets for 2 hours each week to help Veterans begin to heal from the invisible wounds incurred in service through the healing effects of the horse and human connection. This experiential therapy takes place on the serene acres of the Healing Hoofbeats Farm in Bethlehem, CT.



It is facilitated by a Licensed Therapist and an Equine Professional who is also a Combat Veteran. In partnership with our four-legged healers, this therapy team is the perfect storm of mental health expertise and a working knowledge of military service.

SENSORY FRIENDLY FARM

Some may find public settings overstimulating, but want to experience the joy and companionship of the farm animals. At Healing Hoofbeats we understand that need and want to offer these unique individuals or groups the opportunity to engage with our animals in a sensory-friendly way to promote regulation and foster natural learning opportunities.



Facilitated by a mental health professional, this therapeutic experience allows participants to experience true connection with our four-legged healers who come in all shapes and sizes!

YOUTH PROGRAMS

GIRL POWER

We are excited to bring back Girl Power for spring and summer youth programming in 2023 after hosting eight wonderful sessions in 2022. Girl Power is a female empowerment group for teens & tweens! Pre-teen and teen girls can enhance self-esteem by building each other up and working together for a nature-based therapeutic experience on the farm. They will learn all about the benefits of having mutually beneficial relationships with their peers, while modeling these new skills in their growing relationships with our therapy animals.



MINI & ME ON THE FARM

We are excited to share a NEW program coming to Healing Hoofbeats in 2023! Mini and Me will offer guided farm animal interactions with movement, storytime, and crafts for children ages 18 months to 3 years and their parent. This playful group is facilitated by a Licensed Therapist to promote nature-based activities where children will engage in positive explorations while strengthening their family bonds.

GREEN THUMB ACADEMY

Get your kiddos hands in the dirt at Green Thumb Academy! This educational group for elementary age children will help them to get back to our roots and teach the next generation how to grow what they eat.



Each week will have a classroom and experiential portion where we will lern about different topics related to gardening as we cultivate the community garden for all to enjoy.
